or, the wife of a Master Mason who meets the above eligibility requirements



or, the widow of a Master Mason (who met the above eligibility requirements prior to death) who was married for at least five years and has not remarried

HOW TO APPLY



- Call Masonic's Corporate Resource Center at 866.764.6631 to schedule a meeting about your personal circumstances and to determine if you meet requirements.
- If you are eligible, you will be asked to complete an application.
- The approval process will consist of an informational meeting, financial review and personal health assessment.
- The application and approval process can take 90 days or longer.
